- The "Naked" line is made with certified organically grown grapes in a certified organic facility
- The "Nearly Naked" line is made using the entire winemaking toolbox that goes outside of organic standards, in order to maintain the highest quality while still crafting wine from 100% organic grapes, that are not yet certified organic

- Organic wines include Red Truck Organic Zinfandel, Red Truck Organic Petite Syrah, and White Truck Organic Sauvignon Blanc.
- A commitment to eliminating dependence on chemical fertilizers and toxic fungicides and insecticides in favor of natural practices that protect the health and safety of their farm workers, creating a thriving wildlife habitat, and resulting in clean run-off and healthier soils for the future.



- The use of organic compost, produced in the same vineyard, as fertilizer, provides a step forward to sustainable winegrowing.
- The use of rainwater, harvested in the large water reservoirs, and the use of computer controlled irrigation minimizes the use of water in the vineyard.
- Strives to protect the environmental integrity of wine production by adopting a sustainable winegrowing initiative, remaining abreast of the latest developments in grape growing and pest management techniques.



Organic Producers



- Committed to farming, progressive experimentation, and uncompromising quality.
- Designed an environmentally sensitive winery from the top down, utilizing gravity rather than pumps throughout the winemaking process.



- Employ solar-powered weather stations with wireless telemetry to relay data - benefiting water consumption and irrigation needs.
- Integrated Pest Management - cover crops attract beneficial insects to reduce or eliminate the need for pesticides while replenishing soils naturally with organic matter.
- Exercise natural farming solutions to keep water and the environment cleaner.
- Use recycled paper whenever possible for our wine labels and promotional materials.



- Vineyards are farmed without the use of pesticides, herbicides or other chemical sprays.
- Cover crops used to maintain and induce soil vigor, manage pest control, control erosion of the land, help dry the soil in wetter sites, fertilize the soil, and aid in weed control.



Organic Producers



- Cover crops are planted between vineyard rows to control erosion, improve soil structure, add nutrients, and host beneficial predators.
- Encourages the natural growth of native plants along the property boundaries to control invasive weeds and increase plant and animal biodiversity.



- 100% organic wine.
- Vineyards are certified organic, untouched by man-made pesticides and fertilizers.
- Vegan varietals: Chardonnay and Red.



- Sustainability strategy is embodied in six key areas: integrated pest management, responsible water consumption, riparian habitat, wetland restoration, energy efficiency, and recycling programs.

- Constellations Wines Gonzales Winery is home of world's largest winery solar power energy system. Gonzales Winery produces wines distributed by VineOne, the premium and super premium wine division of CWUS.
- Wines produced at the Gonzales Winery include Black Box, Blackstone, and Hayman & Hill.
- Immediate environmental benefits include a reduction in greenhouse gas emissions and an annually reduced carbon footprint equivalent to planting 2,500 acres of trees, not driving an average automobile 25 million miles, or taking more than 2,000 cars off the road.
- Black Box is available in a lightweight, recyclable box that contains 3 liters of wine, which is equal to four regular 750ml bottles.


WYNDHAM ESTATE

- Grapes are grown using the latest irrigation technology so that water is used most efficiently.
- Land care programs such as the rejuvenation of the winery's frontage to the Hunter River have been developed by Wyndham Estate.
- Large areas of native vegetation co-exist with vineyards.
- Preventative measures are taken to minimize the need for chemical sprays.
- Energy efficient through the use of insulated tanks and warehousing, installation of energy efficient lighting, and innovative processing practices.

- The “weeds” between vine rows are actually carefully selected and seeded cover crops like clover, oats, peas and vetch. These leguminous plants help fix nitrogen from the air to “fertilize” the soil and grow tall enough in the spring to attract good bugs that feed on bad bugs harmful to newly budded vines.
- Built owl boxes to encourage these nocturnal hunters to stick around and keep down the critter population.
- Montevina Sauvignon Blanc varietal is vegan.



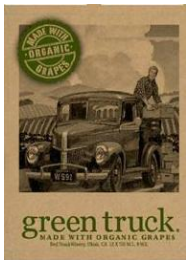
